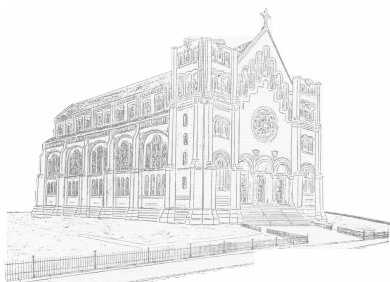

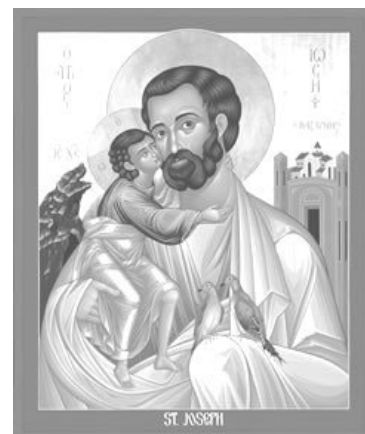

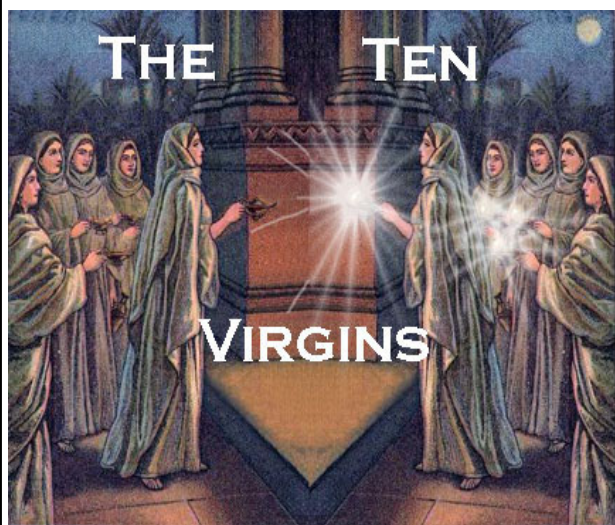

**TODAY’S READINGS**

**First Reading** — “Resplendent and unfading is wisdom...” (Wis 6:12-16)

**Psalm** — “I will remember you upon my couch, and through the night-watches I will meditate on you...” (Psalm 62:2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8)

**Second Reading** — “We do not want you to be unaware brothers and sister, about those who have fallen asleep, so that you may not grieve like the rest, who have no hope.” (1 Thes 4:5-13)

**Gospel** — “Therefore, stay awake, for you do not know neither the hour or the day” (Matthew 25:1-13)

**The Feast of St. Francis Xavier Cabrini– Mother Cabrini** was born on July 15, 1850 in a small village near the city of Milan, Italy. She grew up enthralled by the stories of missionaries and made up her mind to join a religious order. Because of her frail health, she was not permitted to join the Daughters of the Sacred Heart. However, in 1880, with seven young women, Frances founded the Institute of the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Cabrini organized catechism and education classes for the Italian immigrants and provided for the needs of the many orphans. On December 22, 1917, in Chicago, she died. In 1946, she was canonized a saint by Pope Pius XII in recognition of her holiness and service to mankind and was named Patroness of Immigrants in 1950. Mother Cabrini’s feast day is November 13th.
