


After several months of conversation and discernment, the newly formed parish communities of the Archdiocese of New Orleans are prepared to publicly announce their new parish names. This comes after announcements were made in October of last year that 11 parishes from across the metro area would be merging into five new parishes. All changes are effective July 1 of this year.

The following is a listing of the new parishes:

St. John Paul II—is the merger of St. Bonaventure in Avondale and Our Lady of the Angels in Waggaman St. Michael the Archangel – is the merger of St Gertrude in Des Allemands and St. John the Baptist in Para-

Mary, Help of Christians – is the merger of St. John Bosco in Marrero and St. Rosalie in Harvey St. Josephine Bakhita – is the merger of St Mary of the Angels and Our Lady Star of the Sea both of New Orleans

St. Martin de Porres – is the merger of Transfiguration of Our Lord, St James Major, and St Gabriel the Archangel all of New Orleans.

Please pray for the parishioners and pastors of these new parishes that their communities can draw strength from each other during this period of transition and the work of building the Kingdom of God can continue to grow and thrive.


